Privacy Policy

Introduction

At Aceway Tennis Academy, we value the privacy and security of our players, coaches, staff, and visitors. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, store, and protect personal information that we gather as part of our operations. We are committed to ensuring that all personal data is handled responsibly, transparently, and in compliance with data protection laws, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) where applicable.

1. Information We Collect

2. How We Use Your Information

- **Health and Safety**: To ensure the safety of players, particularly for minors, and manage any health-related information in accordance with our duty of care.

- **Marketing**: With your consent, we may use your contact information to send promotional materials, newsletters, and offers related to Academy activities.
- **Improvement of Services**: To assess and improve the quality of services, training programmes, and player experiences at the Academy.

3. Sharing Your Information

We will not sell, rent, or trade your personal data to third parties. However, we may share your personal information with trusted partners and service providers who assist in operating the Academy and delivering services. These third parties will be bound by confidentiality agreements and are prohibited from using your information for any other purpose.

We may also share your personal information with:

- **Legal Authorities**: If required by law, or to comply with a legal obligation, we may share information with regulatory bodies or law enforcement.
- **Emergency Services**: In case of an emergency, we may share health or emergency contact information with medical professionals or emergency responders.

4. Security of Your Information
